

UNITED ENVIROTECH LTD AWARDED RMB 30 MILLION CONTRACT TO DESIGN AND BUILD A WASTEWATER RECYCLING PLANT IN HEGANG CITY, HEILONGJIANG PROVINCE

The Board of Directors of United Envirotech Ltd. ("UEL" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has secured a RMB 30 million contract to construct a wastewater reclamation plant in Hegang City, Heilongjiang Province, China.

UEL was awarded the Engineering, Procurement, Construction (EPC) contract from the Hegang Municipal Government to construct a 30,000 m3/day wastewater recycling facility that will supply recycled water to the chemical plants located in the nearby industrial park.

Commenting on the contract win, Dr Lin Yucheng, Chairman and CEO of United Envirotech said: "Recycled water is becoming a very important alternative water resource given the current water shortages, especially in the North Eastern China. A cost effective supply of good quality recycled water is vital to the fast growing industralisation and it is beneficial to the government, local community and industries as a whole."

"We have established track records in wastewater recycling using advanced membrane technologies. Our Continuous Membrane Filtration (CMF) and Membrane Bio-Reactor (MBR) technologies, which are able to treat wastewater and produce high grade recycled water in a single step, are the cost effective technologies available for wastewater recycling. We believe UEL is well positioned to leverage on the many more wastewater recycling opportunities available in China and overseas."

The project is expected to commence immediately and be completed by the end of December 2010 and will contribute positively to our revenue for our current financial year.
