Statement of comprehensive income

The Group's revenue for the period was \$32.1 million, which was \$11.3 million or 54.2% higher than last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011 of \$20.8 million. The increase was mainly due to the higher engineering revenue for the current period. The engineering revenue increased from \$16.0 million to \$25.3 million, an increase of 58.1%. The treatment revenue increased from \$4.8 million to \$6.8 million, an increase of 41.7%.

The increase in material purchased, consumables used and subcontractors' fees of \$5.9 million or 49.7% as compared to the last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011 was consistent with the increase in the engineering revenue.

The increase in other operating expenses from \$2.7 million to \$3.5 million or 30.3% as compared to the last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011 was largely due to the inclusion of the expenses from the 2 newly acquired subsidiaries, namely Aton Environmental (Shenyang) Co Ltd and Anhui Water Star Treatment and Operation Co Ltd, after 30 June 2011. Both of these subsidiaries managed and operated wastewater treatment facilities.

Finance costs pertained to bank borrowings and convertible bonds. The increase in finance costs from \$0.7 million to \$3.0 million, or 338.7% as compared to the last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011 was mainly due to the finance expense on the convertible bonds of \$2.1 million.

The Group generated profit after tax of \$5.9 million for the current period as compared to \$3.5 million in the last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011, representing an increase of 66.3%. Taking away the effect of the amortization of the equity component of convertible bonds, the Group's net profit would have increased 101.2% to \$7.1 million, as compared to \$3.5 million in the last corresponding period ended 30 June 2011.

Statement of financial position

Total current assets amounted to \$205.6 million, which was \$1.1 million higher than \$204.5 million as at 31 March 2012. The increase was mainly due to higher cash and bank balances and trade receivables.

The cash and bank balances increased from \$89.5 million to \$98.6 million mainly due to the refund of the tender deposit during the current financial period of \$20 million.

Trade receivables increased from \$39.7 million to \$47.2 million. The increase was consistent with the higher revenue generated during the current financial period.

The increase in the total current assets was offset by the decrease in other receivables and prepayments. The other receivables and prepayments decreased from \$73.3 million to \$57.8 million. The reduction was mainly due to the refund of the tender deposit.

As a long term growth strategy for the Group, the Group continues to expand its stable and recurring treatment income and it believes that there are opportunities for TOT/BOT/BOO investment projects in China. The Group will actively seek suitable projects for investment.

The Group believes that there is a growing demand for membrane based water and wastewater treatment services, especially in China. This is mainly due to the stricter discharge limits imposed by the Chinese government and the shortage of water supply in various parts of China. The 12th Five-year plan by the

Chinese government has incorporated clear directive to increase investment in environment and water related projects. The Group believe its advanced membrane technologies, particularly Membrane Bioreactor (MBR), have a competitive edge in treating wastewater of a greater complexity to meet the stricter discharge limits and also to reclaim the treated wastewater for reuse more effectively and efficiently.

During the past few months, the Group secured two membrane based engineering projects, namely drinking water project in Yantai city, Shandong province and upgrading project for the municipal wastewater treatment plant in Liaoyang city, Liaoning province, with a total contract amount of RMB320 million (S\$64 million). In addition, the Group also invested in 3 wastewater and a water supply projects in the industrial parks located in Changyi city, Shandong province. The total capacity for the 4 plants is 150,000m3/day and it is expected to expand to 220,000m3/day in phase 2.
